Becoming a member of our School Board is an excellent way for parents to become involved in the life of the school. Sacred Heart School Board meets monthly during the school term. Well done to the students who are part of our Sacred Heart Mini Vinnies team!

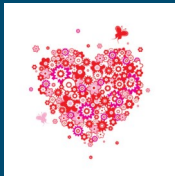

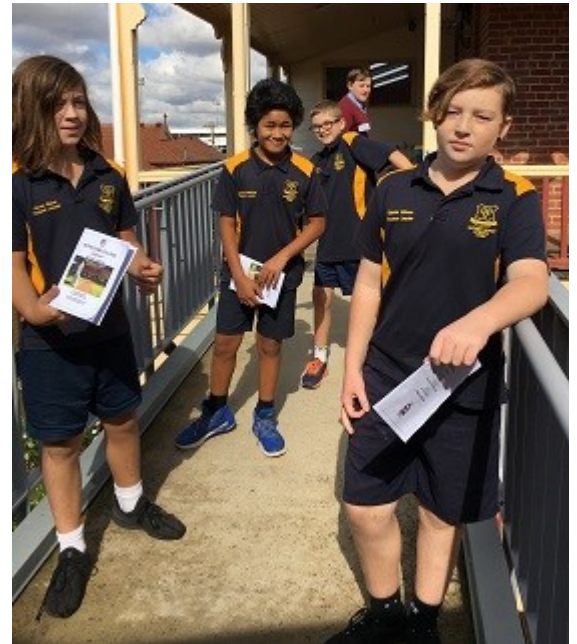
School photos

Children's Chatter Matters

To best prepare our children for the language & learning demands of the school environment, they need ample time and opportunity to engage in meaningful interactions with their family.



Activity 3: An activity to build vocabulary - Etymology

Etymology is the knowledge of where words come from. E.g., Crocodile – the word was founded in the 1560's from a French/Latin spelling of crocodilia, which means large lizard. Finding the origin of the word is interesting and fun, all you need to do is google etymology of... (word). Here are some examples to start you off.

- Nightmare
- Sandwich
- Boxing day
- Bluetooth
- Kangaroo

Have a go at finding the origin of spelling words, unusual words in books or look up some phrases e.g. bite the bullet, bust your chops, raining cats and dogs.

Activity 4: An activity to build vocabulary - Explore different text types

Familiarising your child to different types of texts will allow them to be exposed to different types of words. E.g. Fairy tales, magazines, recipes, instructions, comics, joke books, factual topics. While reading different text types develop a list of tricky or new words e.g. e.g. A recipe: emulsify, fold, combine, separate, pre-heat, rest, knead. You can discuss the meaning of the word or get your child to draw a picture of each word or find a picture of the word on google images and practice using in everyday conversation where appropriate.

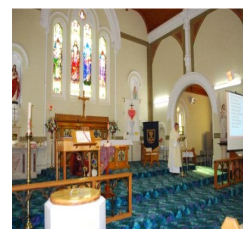

CareMonkey

Parents and caregivers are reminded to keep all details for contacts and students up to date. When changes are made on CareMonkey the administration system is notified and details are also updated there.

New families who have not submitted profiles for their students are asked to do this as soon as possible. All permission notes and important notices are sent to families through the CareMonkey App. Staff have access to details when they are on excursions, camps etc.

SMS Reminder

Parents are reminded not to respond to the SMS sent by the school as it is an automated system.

MEDICATIONS AT SCHOOL

If your child requires medication at school a note identifying the child, class, medication name, dosage, and time to be given needs to be sent to the office.

All medication is dispensed through the office and is signed off on a medication register. If the appropriate permission is not sent with the medication it cannot be given to the student. It is also a good idea to mention to the student's teacher that there is medication at the office and what time it is to be given.

Please notify the school office via a phone call, school app, note or personal visit on the day your child is absent. Teachers will require a written or electronic note as well. Parents will be contacted if their child has an unexplained absence. We ask for your support regarding this important requirement.
